


### **How to Measure for Your Kitchen Remodel**



- 1. Pick a corner as a starting point.
- 2. Work your way around the room clockwise, measuring from corner to corner. \*All measurements should be in inches, including fractions.




- 3. Now, "locate" all openings/doors and windows on your drawing by measuring the distance from the corner to the left of the door/window to the molding at the left side of the opening.
- 4. Measure the width of the opening from left to right, including molding.
- 5. Measure the distance from the molding at the right side of the opening to the corner at the right of the door/window.



\*The sum of these three measurements should be equal to the total length of the wall as measured in step 2.

- 6. If the opening is a window, measure the height of the opening, from bottom to top, including molding.
- 7. If the opening is a window, measure the distance from the floor to the bottom of the window molding.
- 8. Measure your ceiling height. (Measure in a couple of different locations in case the ceiling is not level.)
- 9. If there is a soffit, measure the height and notate the location of the soffit on your drawing.
- 10. Notate the locations of existing features on your drawing, as applicable:
- 11. Make note of additional current conditions:

Your final drawing will now have the information necessary to proceed with the design and planning of your remodel.
